Tour Program

DAY 1: Istanbul Arrival

Welcome to istanbul, Meet your transfer guide at the airport and transfer to your Hotel in Istanbul. The rest of the day is at leisure...

Please note: After going through the passport control, please get your luggage and then walk towards the exit to get out of the customs area and as soon as you get out of the customs, you will see a lot of people waiting in front with signs. Your/our transfer guide will be around there as soon as you come out holding a paper sign bearing your name on it. **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

DAY 2: Istanbul

After breakfast meet your tour guide at the lobby and departure from the hotel, enjoy a **full-day tour of Istanbul** (**Sultanahmet Archaeological Park - Unesco World Heritage**) including a visit to **Topkapi Palace**, residence of the Ottoman Sultans between 1453 and 1852 (excluding harem). Visit the **Hippodrome** which was once the center of life where chariot racing and other public events took place. Tour the **Blue Mosque** built between 1609 and 1616, and famous for its blue ceramic tiles. Your last stop will be the famous **Grand Bazaar**, the world's largest and oldest covered market with over 60 streets. In the evening, consider joining an optional dinner with belly dancing entertainment. Overnight istanbul (B) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

DAY 3: Istanbul / Ankara

After breakfast meet your tour guide at the lobby and departure from the Hotel, enjoy a half day tour of istanbul visit **St. Sophia** museum, it was a church built in the 6th century Byzantine capital, converted to a mosque by the Ottoman empire period, now a museum and one of the world's greatest architectural wonders. In the afternoon, departure for the capital city of **Ankara**. Overnight Ankara (B,D) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

DAY 4 : Ankara / Cappadocia

After breakfast meet your tour guide at the lobby and departure from the Hotel, visit the **Museum of Anatolian Civilizations** with its Hittite treasures and artifacts from the world's oldest city. Continue with a visit of the **Mausoleum of Ataturk**, the burial place of the national hero who founded modern Republic of Turkey. Proceed to **Cappadocia (Unesco World Heritage)**, famous for it's "moon-like" landscapes. En route, visit a 13th century caravanserai. Visit the **underground city of Saratli**. Enjoy dinner at an authentic local restaurant or Hotel. Later in the evening, consider seeing an "optional Whirling Dervishes show & performance". Overnight Cappadocia (B,D) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

DAY 5 : Cappadocia

(early in the morning optional hot air balloon tour experience). After breakfast, visit **Goreme open air museum** (Dark Church is excluded; entrance requires additional admission fee), a historical region of Turkey, located among rock formations. It was first settled back in the Roman period. Many rock churches can still be seen today, as Christianity was then the prevailing religion in that region. Continue to the town of **Avanos**, renowned for its high quality earthenware. Also visit **Pasabag**i and the **Red Valley**, and attend a brief regional pottery workshop in a cave. Overnight Cappadocia (B,D) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

DAY 6: Cappadocia / Konya / Pamukkale

After breakfast meet your guide at the lobby and departure from the hotel for **Pamukkale**. En route, visit the famous **mausoleum of the Sufi philosopher Mevlana**, the worldwide famous mystic figure. Overnight Pamukkale (B,D) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar.**.

DAY 7: Pamukkale / Kusadasi

After breakfast meet your guide at the lobby and departure from the hotel, tour Pamukkale which means "Cotton Castle", describing the white lime cascades formed by hot mineral springs. Visit the ruins of the Roman health spa of Hierapolis (Unesco World Heritage). Continue to Kusadasi. Overnight Kusadasi (B,D) 4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..

Day 8 : Kusadasi - Ephesus & Virgin Mary's House - Kusadasi

After breakfast meet your guide at the lobby and today, tour the ruins of **Ephesus (Unesco World Heritage)**, an important cultural center of the ancient world, and explore the 2,000-year old marble streets, a theater, the Library of Celsius, a gymnasium, and Hadrian's Temple. Take a short drive to see the **Virgin Mary's stone cottage**. Continue to a regional rug production center to have firsthand experience of this unique art form. Overnight Kusadasi (B,D) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

Day 9 : Pergamum - Troy - Canakkale

After breakfast meet your guide at the lobby and departure from the hotel for **Pergamum** and visit the ancient medical center **Asklepion**. Enjoy lunch with locals in a traditional village. Then proceed to **Troy** (**Unesco World Heritage**) with its famous wooden horse, best known for being the setting of the **Trojan War**. Continue to **Canakkale** for an overnight. (B,L,D) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

Day 10: Gallipoli - Dardanelles - Istanbul

After breakfast meet your guide at the lobby and departure for **Gallipoli**, the site of many battles during World War 1. Visit **Anzac Cove**, the **Lone Pine Cemetery**, and **Chunuk Bair**. Then, cross the **Dardanelles** to Istanbul. Enjoy farewell Dinner. Overnight İstanbul (B,D) **4* Star / Deluxe / Boutique Hotels or Similar..**

Day 11: Istanbul - Departure Day

After breakfast transfer to Airport for your return flight home.

Should we cancel your holiday, your deposit and any other payments made will be refunded in full.
